ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

1) Students Feedback about Teaching Leaning and Curriculum:

Feedback is an essential element of teaching-learning process. It can be incorporated to enhance teaching and learning techniques since it has an immediate impact on the process of acquiring knowledge and has a direct impact on both teaching and learning. For the academic year 2023-24, college collects online feedback from Students and Teacherswith the help of Google form specifically designed with structured questionnaire. It was framed by the Feedback Committee and approved by the IQAC. Students and Teachers having freedom and liberty to submit their suggestions, grievances and problems through feedback form. Link of Google form has been created and sent on the respective group accordingly. The analysis and action taken report process is done further by the feedback committee.

For the academic year 2023-24, total 221 students gives their valuable response to the feedback regarding to teaching —learning and curriculum. Total 16 questions based on various teaching learning aspects were asked through Google form questionnaire. The focus of questions was towards overall discipline in the college, teaching methods adopted by the teachers, academic facilities as well as physical facilities made available by the college and other. This feedback helps to understand the problems faced by students it may belongs to timely conduct of lectures, syllabus coverage, effectiveness of teaching, availability of recommended books in the library, apparatus in the laboratories, canteen facility and more. The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with thecurriculum and syllabus of their concerned course program.

Weather curriculum and syllabus provide sufficient knowledge in the area of study? this was the first question of feedback questionnaire. The curriculum and syllabus provide sufficient knowledge in the area of study this response was given by 85% students. Weather entire syllabus is completed within stipulated time? For this question almost 82% students replied that assigned syllabus is completed within stipulated time. In regard to the question pertain to enhancement of skills and capabilities students replied that the present syllabus was useful to enhance Skills and capabilities among students this was the view of more than 84% students. Another question was asked that How would you rate the quality of teaching in your department? The responses received to this question were very much positive. More than 44% students express that quality of teaching was excellent whereas similar number of students feels that the quality of teaching was good. To the response of the question regarding availability and approachability of teachers more than 37% and 55 % students replied that they are very much satisfied and satisfied respectively. In regard to question belongs to Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty cumulatively 88 % students feels that Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty was very good and good. In response to the question regarding availability and condition of classrooms 27% students feels that it is excellent whereas it is good mentioned by 56% students. The condition of classroom found average to 13% students whereas 4% students found this is poor. Another question was asked concern to the availability of resources in the college library. More that 78% students are satisfied regarding the availability of library resources. 13% students doesn't give any response to this question. Another question was asked that How satisfied are you with the cleanness and maintenance of campus facilities? In response to this question 28% student's responded that they are very much satisfied.56%students responded that they are satisfied with the cleanness and maintenance facilities. Almost 16% students found in the view of neutral and not satisfied together. How would you repeated college's efforts in promoting cultural, social, and sports activities? The vas another question includes in the feedback form. Concern to this question always

87% positive response received i.e. excellent and good.remaining 13% response split up into two categories among which 11% was average and remaining was poor. In response to efficiency of college administration 90% students feels that administration is efficient. Does the Skill enhancement course helps in inculcation of skill? This was another question asked in the feedback. More than 77% student's respondent positively and say yes. But remaining students are not sure with this regard responded vary. 41% students feels that faculties in the college are extremely supportive whereas 48% feels those are supportive. How likely are you to recommend this college to others? This was the question, students also responded positively to this question. 90% students are likely to recommend this college to their friends and other closely associates for the admission.

2) Teachers Feedback:

As far as teachers feedback is concern, 44 teachers gives their valuable opinion on various aspects of curriculum, academic and physical facilities, research and many more questions asked in the feedback. Rate the structure of curriculum framed for the entire programme this was the first question asked to teachers. The structure and framework of curriculum found positive to the faculty members because more than 88% teachers combined rate that it is an excellent and good. Another question was asked in respect to Contents and Relevance of the course taught by them, for this question 38% teachers responded as an excellent whereas 47% teachers responded as Good. Mere single response not received to the option poor. Does the syllabus integrate multidisciplinary approaches effectively? This was the next question in the feedback. For this question almost 80% teachers feels yes whereas 13% teachers were not sure for this question.

Does the syllabus encourage active participation and engagement from students? this was another question to the teachers. Giving response, 86% teachers feels yes where as remaining teachers were among those categorial who gives no response and who were not sure. Another question was asked in respect of Flexibility and freedom provided to them in terms of teachers with

methods and assessment. For this question almost 95% teachers are positive with this regard. Another question was Rate the practical experiments/projects/ internship in stimulating the interest of students in the subject. For this question mere 6% teachers rated it as negatively and give the responses like poor and fair. Next question was asked in respect of Support of ICT facilities within the campus? For this question 88% teachers responded positively. remaining 12% teachers were neutral. In respect to adequate, relevant and updated reference material in the library 10% respondent gives negative response. Next question was regarding Supply of consumables and equipments required for teaching and learning. For this question, 90% teachers having positive response whereas remaining 10% teachers were neutral. The similar type of response received to another question which was concern to Provision of infrastructural facilities such as laboratories, conference room, seminar room, etc. The most important question regarding teacher's job satisfaction was asked in the feedback and it was Whether Enough motivation/opportunities for pursuing academic enhancement activities, upgraditing skills and research activities? For this question almost 97% teachers responded positively. In respect to Discipline, Hygiene and cleanness in the campus 81% teachers respond excellent and very good togetherly. But 15% teachers were not sure in this regard. Another question was regarding Efficient and easy conduct of administration, and office work. 95% positive responses also receive for this question. Almost same % of positive response also received to another question which was pertaining to Recreational activities for work-life balance. Next important question was asked to teachers and it was about Grievance redressal mechanism for teachers. For this question 25% teachers were responded that they are extremely satisfied with this mechanism whereas 63% teachers were responded as satisfactory. Almost 11% teachers were neutral with this regard.

After the analysis and interpretation of both feedbacks the clear picture reveal regarding to the views of different stakeholders. Above all issues are taken into consideration in the meeting of feedback analysis compatible.

Discussion is done with principal regarding negative responses and suggestions

given by the stakeholders. It was decided that teachers should give more focus on their teaching quality and teaching methods. More attention should given on the presence of students in the classrooms. With this regard use of ICT in teaching and learning is optimized by teachers in the college. Interactive classes with power point presentation have increased for the benefit of the students. In response to some negative comments regarding to classroom conditions more attention was given to the classroom conditions in respect of infrastructural facilities, maintenance, cleaning and hygiene. It was also decided that more fund should made available for library for acquisition of student oriented library resources. In respect of co-curricular activities, cultural and sports facilities it is decided that to organize more co-curricular activities in the college. It is also decided that to encourage and motivate students to participate in NSS programs, youth festival and other similar platforms. Regarding to co-curricular activities university level sports competitions should organize in the college. Another significant decision taken that is to organize special lectures on competitive examinations and time table should reserve for the same. Pratibha lecture series should run continuously with effective way for students and teachers to impart wider knowledge apart from the curriculum. The open suggestions suggested by the stakeholders are also discussed and decided to organize more online classes if the situation demands. More emphasize should give on the study tour, laboratory practical's, reading room facilities, cool drinking water facility, Canteen, sports facilities and more.
