## **Analysis and Action taken Report**

**(Student Feedback about Teaching Learning and Curriculum)**

**(Teachers |Feedback)**

Feedback is an essential element of teaching-learning process. It can be incorporated to enhance teaching and learning techniques since it has an immediate impact on the process of acquiring knowledge and has a direct impact on both teaching and learning. For the academic year 2022-23, college collects online feedback from different stake holders with the help of Google form specifically designed with structured questionnaire. It was framed by the Feedback Committee and approved by the IQAC. Stake holders having freedom and liberty to submit their suggestions, grievances and problems through feedback form. For the year 2022-23 online feedback has been collected from two categories of stake holders that is Students and Teachers. Google form has been created and the link of the same is sent on the respective group accordingly. The process of analysis and action taken report is done further by the feedback committee.

For the academic year 2022-23, total **156** students gives their valuable response to the feedback regarding to teaching-learning and curriculum. Total 18 questions based on various teaching learning aspects were asked through google form questionnaire. The focus of questions was towards overall discipline in the college, teaching methods adopted by the teachers, academic facilities as well as physical facilities made available by the college and other. This feedback helps to understand the problems faced by students it may belongs to timely conduct of lectures, syllabus coverage, effectiveness of teaching, availability of recommended books in the library, apparatus in the laboratories, canteen facility and more. The

analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the curriculum and syllabus of their concerned course program. Almost 93% students feels that assigned syllabus surely provide adequate knowledge concerned to the subject area. More than 85% students replied that assigned syllabus is completed within stipulated time. Skills and capabilities among students will also increase with the help of present syllabus this was the opinion of almost 90% students. Another question was asked that whether students feel that academic process and other initiatives in the college found transparent or not. More than 91% students respondent positively to this question and they feel the process is transparent. Another question was asked concern to their placement or recruitment. Almost 80% students feels that course contents are definitely found helpful for their future progress and will allow them for placement. 85% students feel that library holdings are satisfactory. Library should focus on its collection to satisfy the documentary needs of remaining students. More than 90% students believe that teachers came to conduct the class with well preparation. Teachers found available for the students during as well as apart from college working hours and more than 75% students gives positive response to the same. More than 80% students found impressed with the usage of teaching aids and ICT tools made by their teachers for the teaching and learning. Almost 15% students feels that the co-curricular and extracurricular activities organized by the college are not up to the mark, this point should take into consideration. The another significant question was asked and it was regarding to the overall learning experience of students. More than 43% students feels it as excellent whereas more than 50% students feels it was a good experience. Less than 5% students doesn't feels it is positive. Almost similar type of response received to the question regarding students willingness towards to pursue another course through college.




Feedback on various aspects of curriculum, academic and physical facilities, research is received from 33 faculty members of Pratibha Niketan College. The structure and framework of curriculum found positive to the faculty members because more than 95% teachers feel that there is a good balance in syllabus regarding theory and practical applications. The environment in the college found extremely helpful for the teaching and research this opinion given by more than 69% teachers. To update skills and qualifications of teachers, whether college provide adequate opportunities or not this was the next question asked in the feedback and 100% positive responses received to this question. Similar % response also received to the question regarding to the teacher friendly administration. In respect of flexibility and freedom given by college to teachers for adopting new teaching techniques (group discussion, seminars etc) 97% teachers given positive response. Exact same % positive response received regarding to the provision made by the college regarding to the ICT facilities. Library collection is adequate and frequently updated this was the opinion of 93% teachers. The real negative response received in respect of conduct of internal unit test/ examinations. More than 24% teachers having negative response to the question. Supply of consumables for teaching and learning found extremely satisfied this was the opinion of 51% teachers. Though 88% teachers gives positive response towards question of infrastructural facilities but this also fact that remaining 12% teachers are not feels like that.

After the analysis and interpretation of both feedback the clear picture reveal regarding to the views of different stakeholders. Above all issues are taken into consideration in the meeting of feedback analysis committee. Discussion is done with principal regarding negative responses and suggestions given by the stakeholders. It is decided that internal examinations/ unit test should be conduct within stipulated time. More attention should give on the presence of students in

the internal examinations. The another issue discussed that was regarding to organize more co-curricular activities in the college. It is decided that to encourage and motivate students to participate in NSS programs, youth festival and other similar platforms. Regarding to co-curricular activities university level sports competitions should organize in the college. Another significant decision taken that is to organsie special lectures on competitive examinations and time table should reserve for the same. Pratibha lecture series should run with effective way for students and teachers to impart wider knowledge apart from the curriculum. The open suggestions suggested by the stakeholders are also discussed and decided to organize more online classes if the situation demands. More emphasize should give on the study tour, laboratory practical, reading room facilities, cool drinking water facility, sports facilities and more.

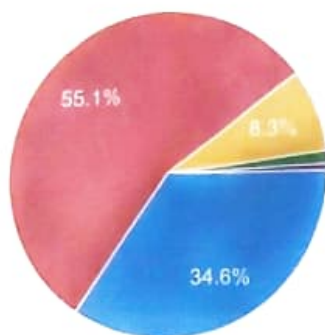

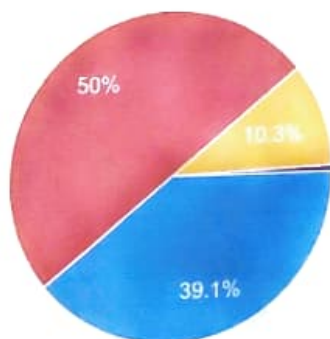

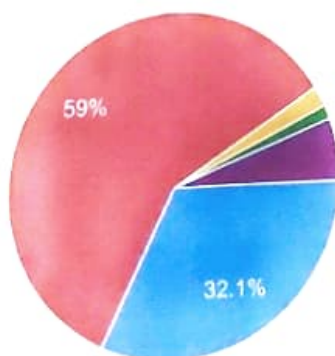

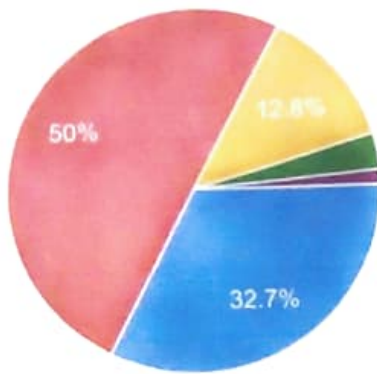

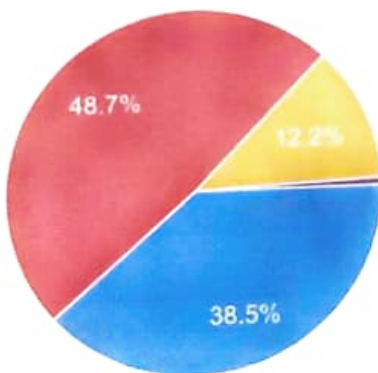

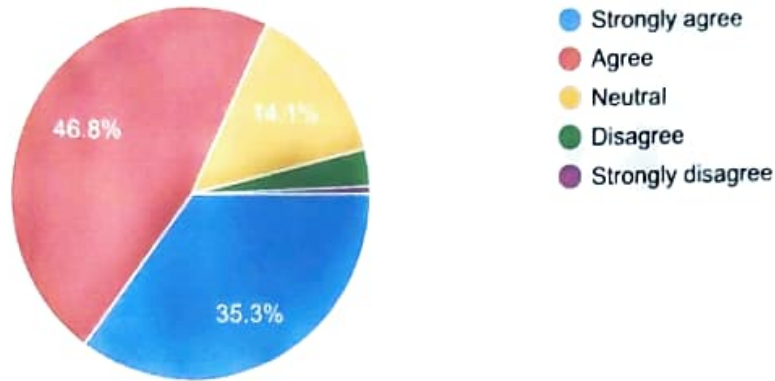

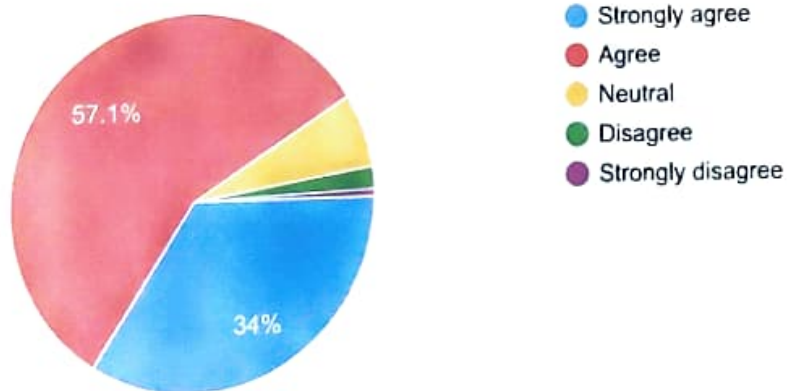

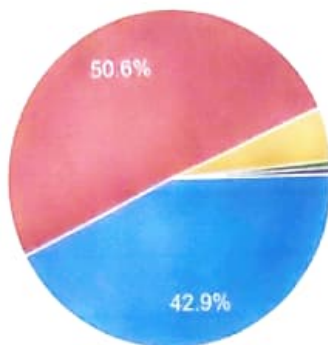

### 9) Teachers come well prepared to the class?

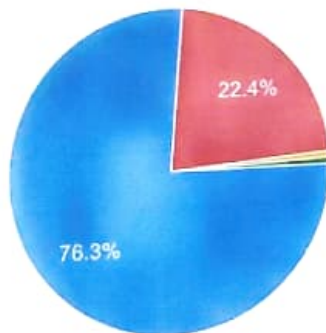

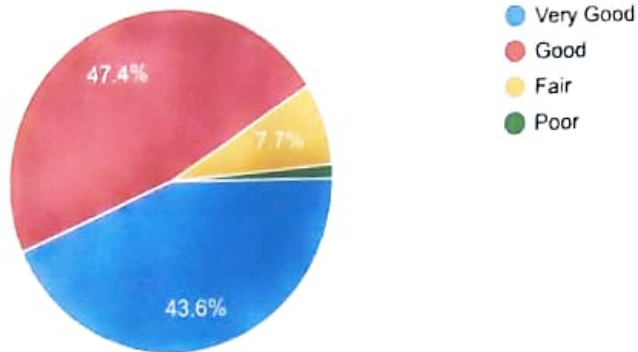

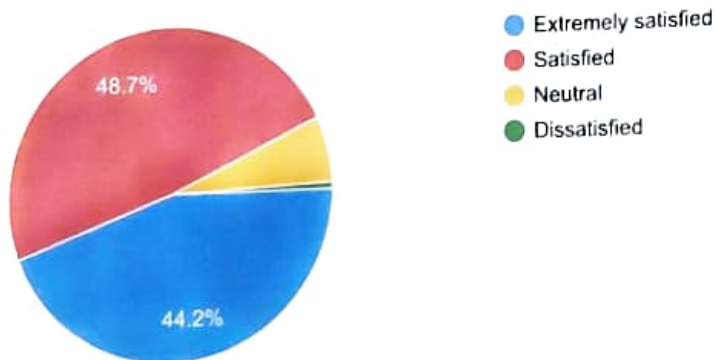
### 11) Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching

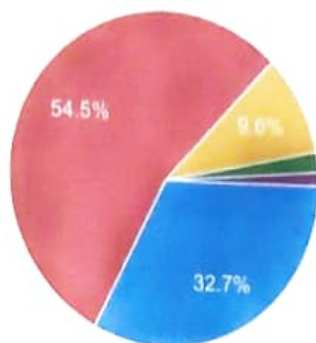

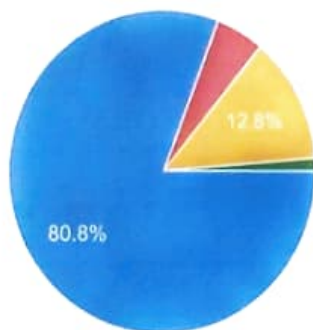

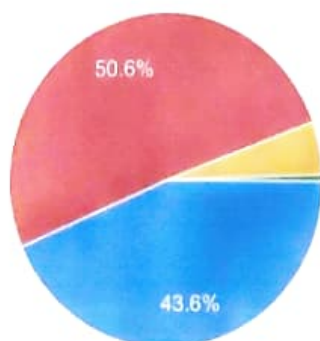

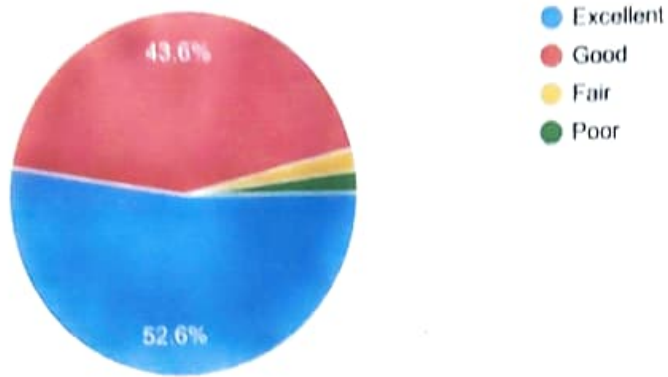

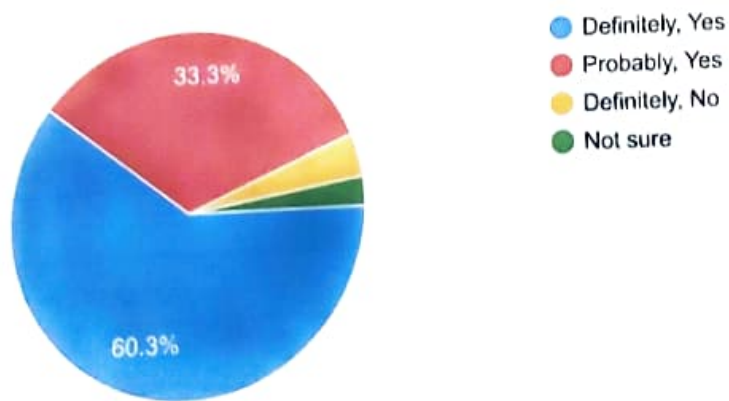

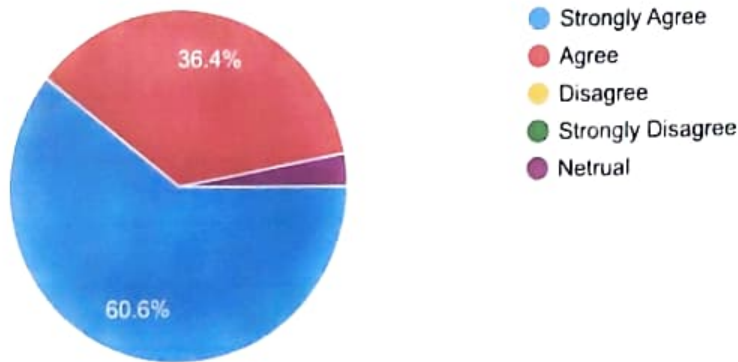

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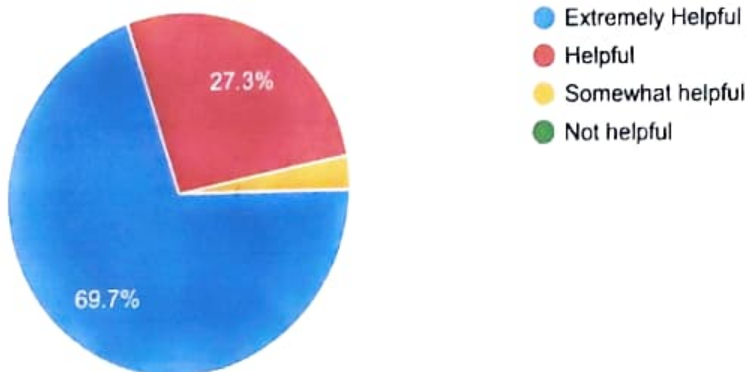

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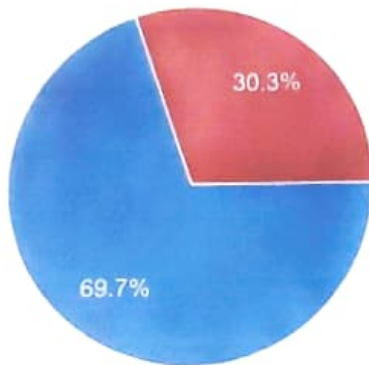

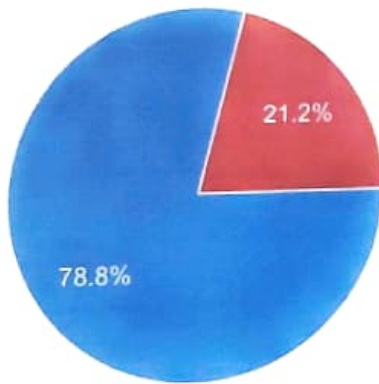

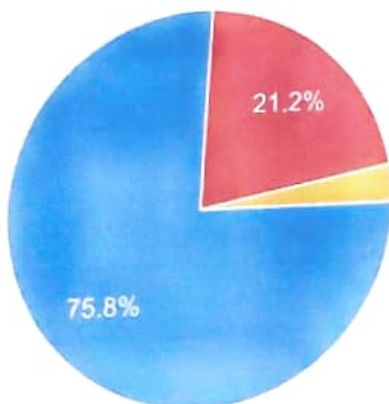

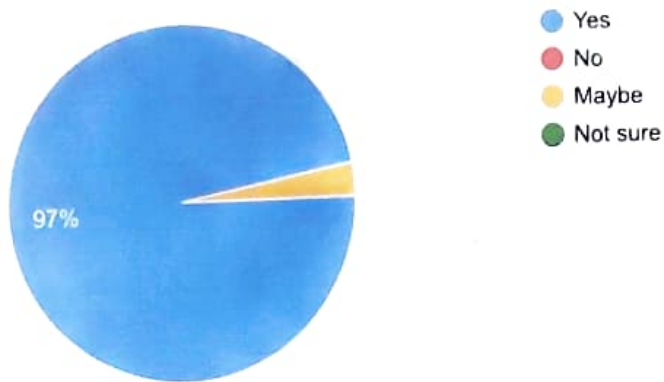

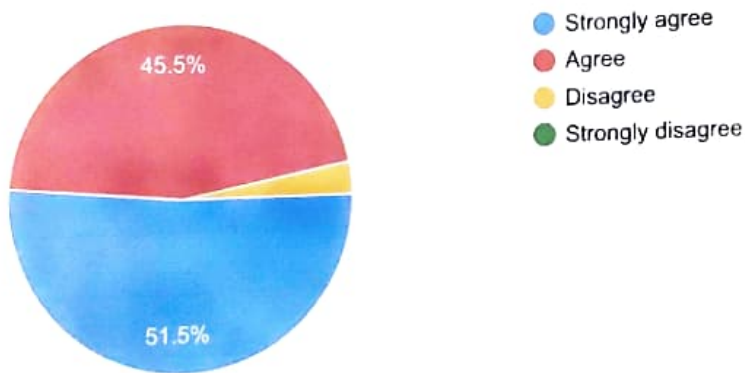
6: Whether college gives you full freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations, learners' participation and other ?

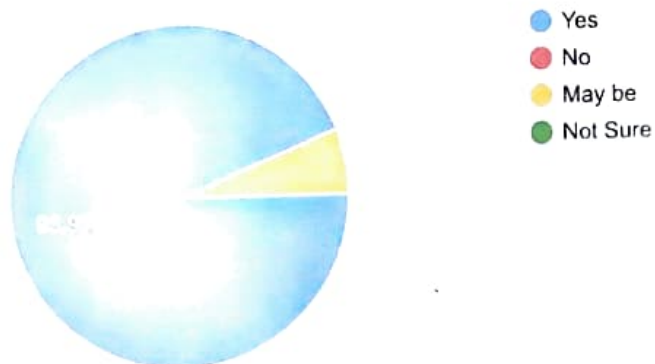

8: Whether available books/journals prescribed as reference materials are relevant /updated by the library, and cover the entire syllabi?

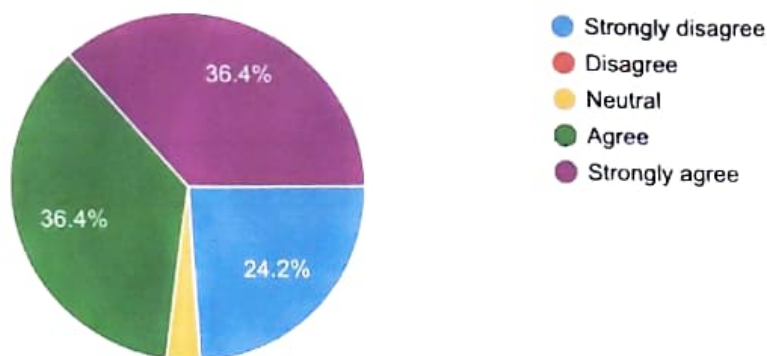

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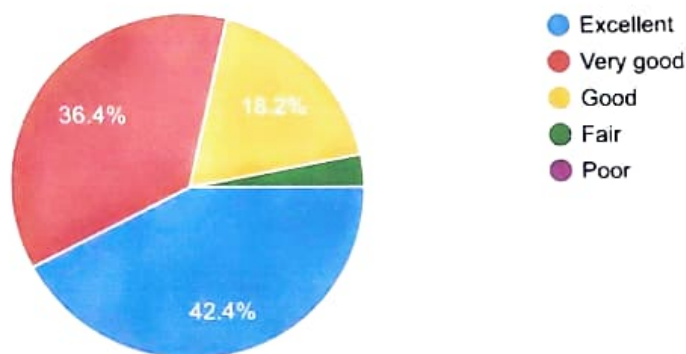
